**ELECTION CANVASS MINUTES**

NOVEMBER 14, 2019

6:20 PM

The canvass of the November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 general and special elections per Election Code 67.001-67.004 was called to order by Mayor Bennett at 6:20 PM. Quorum established with all Council members present except Councilman Priddy. City Attorney Mr. Brad Elrod was present and there were 18 individuals present in the audience.

**Agenda Item #1 –Canvass of November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 general and special elections**

Mayor Bennett informed Council the voting machine “tape” printout of both the general and special election had been provided by the County Clerk’s office that afternoon after the county ballot board had completed review of provisional votes. She noted that the vote tally for both the Council election and the sales tax election are detailed in the ordinances to be voted on in the next 2 agenda items.

**Agenda Item #2 –Ordinance #2020-1 declaring & accepting result of November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 general election**

Mayor Bennett read Ordinance #2020-1 which provides the ballot totals for each candidate in early and Election Day voting. Councilman Warren made the motion to approve Ordinance #2020-1. Councilman Morris voiced the second. In discussion it was pointed out the Ordinance contained the year 2015 in one of the “whereas” sections. Councilman Warren amended his motion to approve Ordinance #2020-1 with date correction to 2019. Councilman Morris amended his second likewise, and Council unanimously approved Ordinance #2020-1 with the correction.

**Agenda Item #3 –Ordinance #2020-2 declaring & accepting result of November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 special election**

Mayor Bennett read Ordinance #2020-2 which provides the ballot totals for the 1 ½% general sales and use tax results in early and Election Day voting. Councilman Herrington made the motion to approve Ordinance #2020-2. Councilman Warren provided the second and Council voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

**Agenda Item #4 – Adjourn**

Councilman Vonderlin made the motion to adjourn with a second by Councilman Warren, and the meeting was concluded at 6:25 PM.
