Election Canvass of the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 General election was called to order by Mayor Bennett at 11:00 AM. Quorum established with Council members Will Warren, Skip Blackstone and Chuck Vonderlin present. The meeting was being live streamed via the city Facebook page.

**Agenda Item #1 – Canvass of votes**

Mayor Bennett turned the floor to City Secretary/Elections administrator C. D. Woodrome to provide the vote tally as provided by the County Clerk's office following the verification of provisional votes by the early voting ballot board. The total number of voters in Precinct box #3 for early voting was 904, with 308 votes on election day. In the Mayor race: Cathy Bennett received 330 votes, Ray McGlaun received 321. In the Council election for two positions: John Craven received 376 votes, Will Warren received 312, and Karen Fidler received 267.

**Agenda Item #2 – Ordinance #2021-1 declaring and accepting the November 3, 2020 election votes**

Mayor Bennett read Ordinance #2021-1 declaring and approving the vote tally of the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 election. Councilman Blackstone made the motion to approve Ordinance #2021-1 with Councilman Vonderlin providing the second and the motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Warren made the motion to adjourn with a second by Councilman Blackstone and the election canvass was concluded at 11:08 AM.
